- ◆ Began his broadcasting career in 1962 at WAGS (Bishopville)
- ◆ Worked as on-air talent and account executive over the decades at WAGS, WDXY, WFIG, WICI, WIBZ and Miller Communications
- ◆ Hosts, sells and produces “Grady Brown at the Beach,” a five-hour beach music show heard every Sunday on five stations
- ◆ Represents Lee & Sumter Counties (District 50) in the SC House of Representatives and has for over 25 years
- ◆ Serves on the House Labor, Commerce and Industry Committee and the Banking and Insurance and Utility Subcommittee
- ◆ Spearheaded legislation to implement a program to irradiate the boll weevil when SC’s number one cash crop, cotton, was being destroyed
- ◆ Recognized by the Utility Industry of SC for his efforts to defeat deregulation and by DHEC for his extensive work to reduce the rate of infant mortality in small, rural counties
- ◆ Founder of two family-operated businesses, Grady & Son Furniture and Grady’s Barber Shop, and a licensed auctioneer
- ◆ Served in the SC Air National Guard
- ◆ Exemplary community servant having served numerous organizations
- ◆ Key advocate for broadcasters at the SC State House for decades
